如何记录移民与海关执法局行动

致 敬

注意识别徽章及标识：国土安全部、移民与海关执法局 (ICE)、海关边境保护局 (CBP)、烟酒烟草及爆炸物管理局 (TTF) 等
时间日期：事件发生时间？
装备武器：是否携带武器？何种类型？使用何种车辆？车牌号？

个人权利须知

1. 您无需开门。移民与海关执法局 (ICE) 无权在未持有法官签发的有效搜查令的情况下进入您的住所。您可以要求他们将搜查令递入。
2. 您可要求其离开。若您未持搜查令擅自进入您的住所，您可要求其退出并声明不同意搜查。
3. 您有权保持沉默。第五修正案保障您保持沉默、避免自证其罪的权利。
4. 您无需透露个人信息。您依法无义务提供移民身份、出生地或犯罪记录等信息。任何言行都可能被用作不利证据，切勿说谎。
5. 您无需签署文件或交出证件。在未咨询律师前，您依法无义务签署任何文件。
6. 您有权咨询律师。

雇主须知：您的权利

- 在移民与海关执法局 (ICE) 到来前：
1. 制定书面应对方案。将方案分发给员工和管理层，确保所有人知晓行动要领。务必演练方案！
 2. 联系移民律师。为员工提供可提供免费或低成本移民法律咨询的律师或机构名单。
 3. 加入移民应对网络。了解本地其他雇主的应对措施。
 4. 培训员工。确保他们知晓自身权利及最佳应对方案：
 - 一切勿逃跑。逃跑可能为 ICE 提供逮捕员工的法律依据。
 - 一切勿回答问题或提供任何信息。
 - 一切勿允许 ICE 人员进入工作场所。
 5. 张贴“员工专用”标识。工作场所属于私人财产。根据《宪法第四修正案》，执法部门未经法官签发的搜查令不得擅自进入。

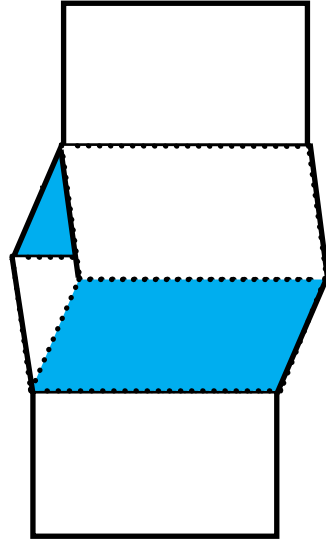
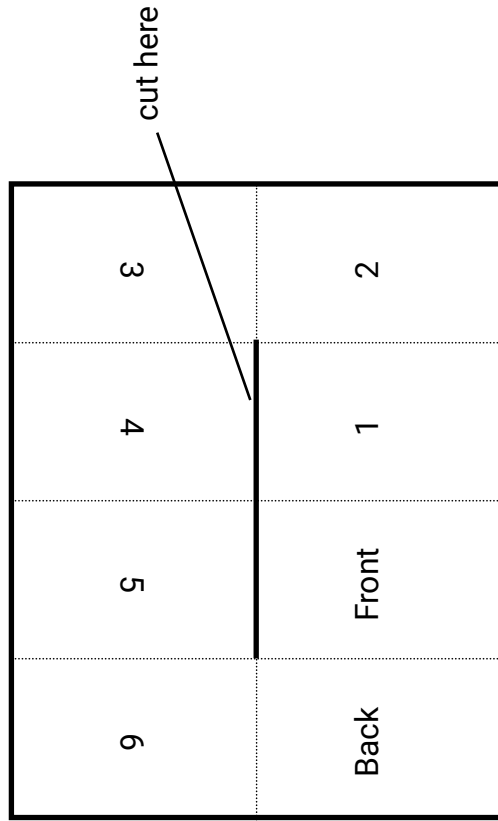

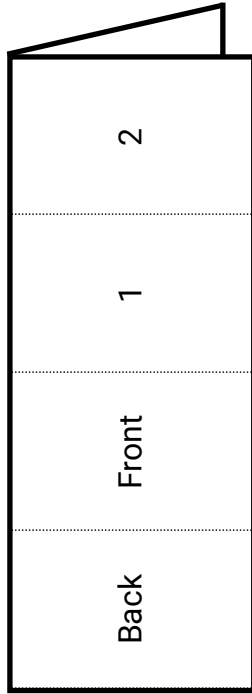

HOW TO FOLD AN 8-PAGE ONE SHEET ZINE

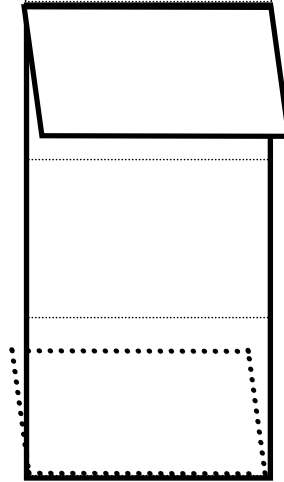


push in the ends

like a diamond

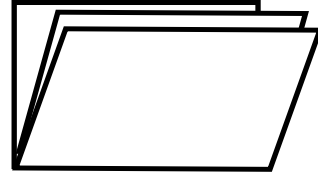


flatten the diamond

fold in half lengthwise

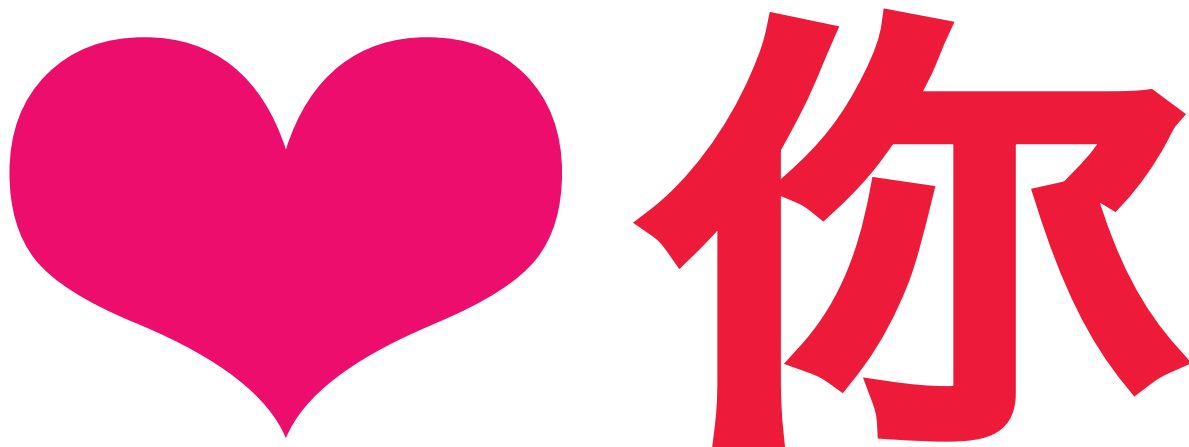


fold one end toward

and your zine is done!

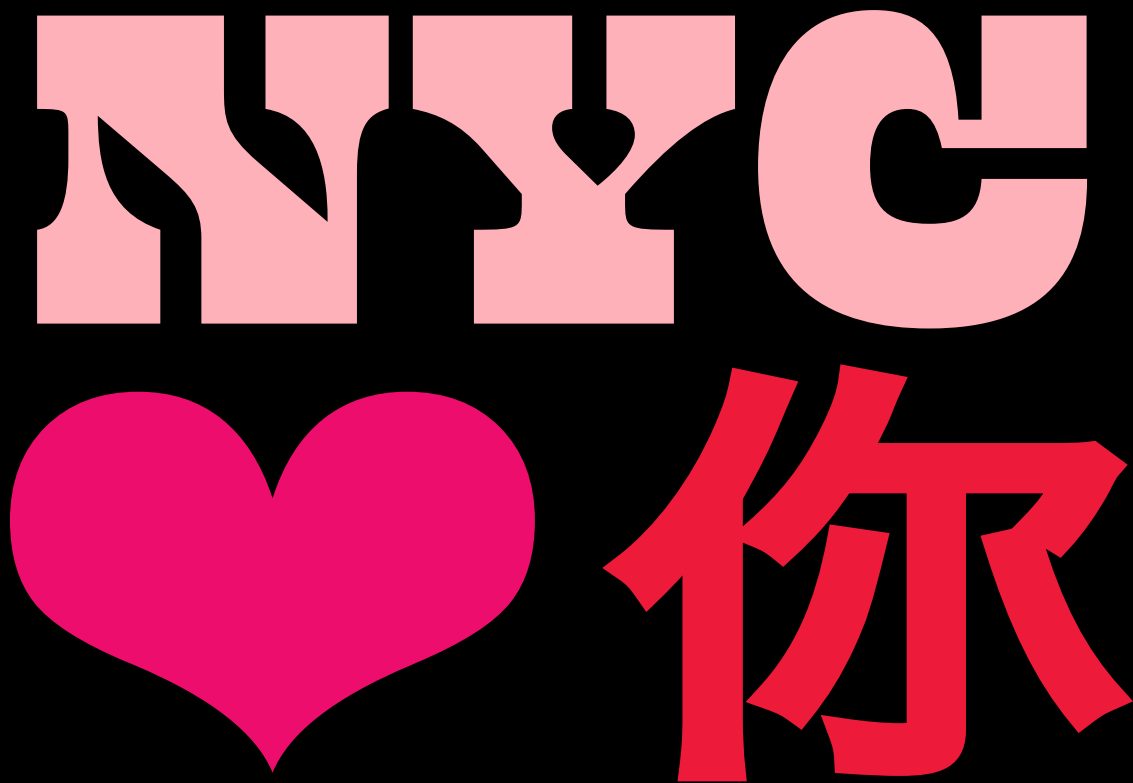

NOTICE TO ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT & IMMIGRATION AGENTS

- ▶ This is a private workplace. You are not permitted to enter non-public areas of this business (including offices, breakrooms, storage areas, and staff only areas) without a judicial warrant signed by a federal judge or magistrate.
- ▶ An ICE administrative warrant (Form I-200 or I-205 does not authorize entry into private areas of this business.
- ▶ You may not question employees or search the premises without proper legal authority.
- ▶ All employees and visitors have the right to remain silent and the right to an attorney.



IF YOU ATTEMPT TO ENTER THIS PROPERTY WITHOUT A VALID JUDICIAL WARRANT, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.



IF YOU PRESENT A JUDICIAL WARRANT, PLEASE NOTIFY MANAGEMENT AND LEGAL COUNSEL IMMEDIATELY BEFORE PROCEEDING.



IF YOU ENTER, YOU ARE TRESPASSING, AND WE WILL SEEK LEGAL RECOURSE.
